Comment on Planning Application: S/05/36 Lane Side, Casterton

Householder planning permission for demolition of existing single storey extensions; erection of new single and double storey extensions to provide garage and additional living space together with internal and external alterations to the property

Dear Mr Davis

Friends of the Dales wish to comment as follows: although not of the Arts & Crafts period, this house (and also its neighbour) shows some influences of that movement. These will be lost if self-coloured composite cladding is used above the string course on all the external walls. This is not a vernacular finish, and most village properties are stone faced and/or rendered. We would strongly recommend a finish more in keeping with the neighbourhood.
