Full planning permission for conversion of barn to form a camping barn

Dear Ms Thompson

Friends of the Dales accepts that the application relating to this small classic isolated field barn, well outside Threshfield and Skirethorns, is for a low-key use which will require no access track or services and minimal alteration to its structure. We suggest however that permitted development rights be removed and that any permission makes clear that a future application for upgrading to a permanent dwelling would not fall within policy.
