**Objection to Planning Application: R/50/59A The Cottage, Woodhall**

**Householder planning permission for demolition of existing single storey rear extension, two storey side extension and detached garage; erection of single storey rear extension, two storey side extension with recessed terrace, lean-to, and amendments to car parking provision**

Dear Ms White

**Friends of the Dales object to this application for the following reasons:**

- The proposed glazing on the north side, on both the ground floor and the first storey, is excessive and out of character with the barn.
- In addition, the proposal increases the footprint of the barn significantly, perhaps by as much as about another third or half - so that the form, character and interest of the barn will be lost. Bearing in mind that the policy on barn conversions is a conservation policy, this is neither conservation of the barn nor is it contributing to the visual quality of the hamlet of Woodall.

**For the reasons listed above we object to this application.**
