Designed to take visitors into the Yorkshire Dales from surrounding urban areas, and also to provide a service for local inhabitants.

Managed by a voluntary not for profit community interest company (D&BCIC) – a subsidiary of Friends of the Dales.

We raise money, plan and market services and contract with bus operators to run the services.

No of passengers 41731

Cost £187,000

Fares revenue £ 93,000

Net Funding Needed £ 94,000

So £2.2 per passenger versus £5 benefits

Problems

- Funding fragmented and short term
- NYC refusal to finance 'leisure' services or any Sunday or evening services
- Heavy dependence on a small number of volunteers
- Rising costs and shortages of drivers

Prospects

- Positive statement about public transport from YDNPA
- New local authority NYC
- Expectation of an Elected Mayor in 2024
- New local transport plan with public transport 'at its heart'
- Agreement that FOTD and DBCIC will work together to campaign for improved public transport in the Dales and surrounding area
